For homeowners, renters, and businesses of all sizes, and private non-profit organizations affected by severe storms and flooding beginning on April 23 – May 9, 2011.

Please have the following information available when you call:

- A phone number and a reliable alternate in case we need to call you back
- Address of the damaged property
- Social Security number
- Current mailing address
- Brief description of damages
- Insurance information (if you have insurance)
- Income and bank account information

Disaster Assistance May Include:

- Grants to cover essential personal property losses
- Low-interest loans available through SBA
- Housing assistance
- Basic disaster recovery needs
- Basic needs not covered by insurance
- Uninsured medical, dental, funeral, and other misc. expenses

Disaster recovery assistance is available without regard to race, color, sex, religion, national origin, age, disability, or economic status.
