The Planning Commission continues work on the Town Plan. Upcoming meeting dates and topics can be found at tinyurl.com/2019TownPlan. Current surveys and survey results for these topics are online. The Development Review Board met on July 10th and approved:

- 1) Conditional use application of Marcel Lemay for a 48ft. by 80 ft. barn at 384 Depot Rd.
- 2) Preliminary plat application of Seth Wright for a four lot planned unit development subdivision of a 47 acre parcel resulting in three new single family residences.

The Board also heard three two plan applications:

- 1) Sketch plan application of the Burlington Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses, Inc. for a two lot planned unit development consisting of a 3.6 acre parcel and a .175 acre parcel developed with a church and a single family residence that will convey 3,831 sq. ft. from the church parcel to the residential parcel at 610 Main Street and 626 Main Street
- 2) Sketch plan application of Pauline Lapierre, Darren Eddy, and Richard Eddy for a planned unit development on a 15.24 acre parcel to demolish an existing 6,910 sq. ft. commercial building and construct a 25,000 sq. ft. multi-use





building consisting of 6,000 sq. ft. of commercial and 30 residential units at 3424 Roosevelt Highway.

The summer Water Quality Program is back for its 14th year! Water quality tests are taken by town staff at 9 public swimming areas, including multiple samples from Bayside Beach and Rossetti Natural Areas, on Mondays and Wednesdays from mid-June through the end of August. The samples are sent to a lab that tests for e. coli, a bacteria that can cause human health problems including gastroenteritis. Swimmers should steer clear of streams and areas where streams or storm drains flow into the lake. Sampling locations, past and current year water quality test results, and other program information can be found at www.colchestervt.gov/487/Water-Quality-Results.

- Working with the Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation to increase available funding for the Malletts Bay Sewer Project
- Developing funding plan for the reconstruction of the Bayside intersection
- We are developing the necessary protocols for conducting a condition assessment of the Town's stormwater system in support of future maintenance and capital programs.
- Focusing on completing the patching project on Blakely Road
- Developing contract documents for the renovation of the basement of the Meeting House
- Mountain View Drive Sidewalk is nearing completion
- Spot Repairs of sidewalk along College Parkway are complete
- Upcoming East Road culvert project is scheduled for mid-July.
- Capital Paving Program contract has been awarded and is tentatively scheduled for late July into August.
- Developing a scope of work for the replacement of failed stormwater pipes on Reynolds Drive.
- A complicated right-of-way issue for the Laker Lane Intersection project is nearing resolution and the town anticipates proceeding to construction next
- Plans for the West Lakeshore Drive shared use path project are in the final stage of review. The Town would like bidding and construction to start this summer with completion next spring.

Notices: Construction Update Routes 7/2, 2A Intersection Improvement Project – Rough Road Ahead for Next Two Weeks

For the next 2 weeks travel will be slow and bumpy on Route 7/2 between Route 2A and north of the Creek Farm Road intersection. The contractor will be removing about 900 feet of pavement and concrete slab underneath Route 7/2. Travel will be slow due to rough gravel surface and lane closures. Cyclists are advised to proceed slowly. Seek an alternate route if possible. Morning commuters are advised to get through the work zone by 8:30 AM before one-lane travel begins. Questions?
