## Planning and Zoning Department Sarah Hadd, Director


The Colchester Selectboard asked the Planning Commission to gather public input, develop options for addressing longstanding wastewater issues in the Inner Bay, and report back to the Selectboard in September 2019.

The Planning Commission will explore options to address wastewater pollution in Inner Mallets Bay. Options that the Commission will evaluate include:

- Extending the Town sewer line
- Developing community septic systems
- Buying up properties as they become available
- Installing composting toilets

The Planning Commission will begin by preparing objective materials to help residents consider these options. These materials will address issues related to land use/zoning, parks and recreation, transportation, and stormwater in Inner Malletts Bay.

The Colchester Planning Commission will hold events on May 20 to gather public input. We will have a "Walk and Talk" meeting starting at the Bayside Activity Center in Upper Bayside Park at 4:00 PM on May 20, and a Public Forum at 7:00 PM May 20th in the Colchester High School Cafeteria. # Department of Public Works Bryan Osborne, Director

- The contractor is making very good progress on the West Lakeshore Drive Shared-Use Path Project. The contract completion is scheduled for the end of August, 2019, however the work may be finished early.
- This summer's paving program is now underway. The first phase of the paving will be West Lakeshore Drive, from Prim Road to the Bayside intersection, and Blakely Road from Malletts Bay Avenue to Rt. 7. The second phase will include West Lakeshore Drive from Prim Road to Church Road following the completion of the bike path project, and then all of Church Road.
- We are continuing to advance the design for the reconstruction of the Prim and West Lakeshore Drive Intersection project
- While the Laker Lane/Blakely Road intersection project is ready to build and construct, it will now be deferred until next summer as the State did not expect the Town to advance the project so quickly and therefore had not programmed the construction funds for this year.
- Discussions with the CCRPC and VTrans are continuing to advance the design a roundabout at the Bayside intersection.
- We are continuing the design for stormwater improvements in Shore Acres and the surrounding area to improve water quality in Malletts Bay.
- Work is continuing on the development of a phosphorus control plan to improve water quality in Malletts Bay.
- Bids have been received for the replacement of a large drainage culvert under Hercules Drive that has failed. Work on this project is expected to begin in July-August of this year.
- A grant has been obtained to perform 30% engineering for the replacement of culverts beneath Lower Mt. View Drive.
- Work on the town-wide stormwater system condition assessment is now substantially complete. The information will now be used to develop an asset management program, capital budget, and refine our stormwater system maintenance programs.
- Street sweeping and gravel road maintenance are ongoing.
