The Town website, www.colchestervt.gov has been updated to simplify use on mobile devices, focus on Town services and provide simpler navigation.

There are five main navigation areas:

- Town Services includes information on Town departments that provide direct public services: Assessor, Cemeteries, Economic Development, Parks & Recreation, Planning & Zoning, Public Works, Police, Rescue, and Town Clerk
- Library now features:
 - o Traditional library lending services for adults, children, and young adults
 - o Computer and internet access, scanning, printing, and copying
 - o Online classes from accounting to writing; language learning; and preparation for testing, from commercial driver's licenses to law school admissions
 - o Events and activities: There are over 70 programs offered in December for people of all ages, including: tutoring, a Gingerbread/Graham Cracker House Contest, needle felting, escape rooms, yoga, and music for toddlers
 - o Read & More includes audio books, e-books, sets of books for discussion groups, maker kits, and museum & park passes
- Local Services includes services not provided by the Town: Colchester Historical Society, Colchester School District, Fire Departments, and Water Supply Services
- Government Boards & Commissions, Schedule for Public Meetings, Town Volunteers, State Representatives, Finance Department, Human Resources and Town Manager
- Contact Us includes department directories with phone and email contacts. If you have a service question we can better assist you when contacted directly, as it is easier to get follow up information.

The Planning Commission continues to work on the Malletts Bay Initiative Wastewater Solutions and invites the public to provide comments on its draft findings by December 13th through the PZ Office at 781 Blakely Rd. or email at shadd@colchestervt.gov. The Commission will hold a hearing on Supplement to the Development Regulations correcting shed setbacks and other minor corrections on December 17th at 7PM at the Town Offices.
