Town Manager's Message



86.6% of Chittenden County residents 12+ have received one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine as of August 20, 2021.




Covid-19 Among Fully Vaccinated People in Vermont

From January 1, 2021 to August 13, 2021

Of 418,230 Fully Vaccinated Vermonters:

- 630 tested positive (.15%)
- 18 hospitalized for Covid-19 (.004%)
- 8 died due to Covid-19 (.002%)

Department Spotlight - Fire Service Improvements

Over the last year, the town completed a needs assessment of the three fire stations turned over to the town in 2020. The Department of Public Works has been programming longer-term work into the Fire Capital Plan, overseeing inspections, and performing preventative maintenance and repairs with the help of the DPW staff, the Parks and Recreation Department, and the firefighters. Work completed includes:

Inspection & Preventative Maintenance

 Center Station on Main Street: Air handling systems, boiler, clearing of catch basin, fire protection system, outlet replacement with GFCI, rectify tripping hazards, restroom faucet, and leak repair, split system – HVAC, transformer

- Champlain Station on Clay Point Road: Furnace, wall panel repair, water heater
- Malletts Bay Station on Church Road: Air handling systems, boiler, fire
 protection system, kitchen hood filter cleaning, overgrown vegetation in
 air handling systems, pests roosting in exhaust fan, split system HVAC

Improvements

- Center Station on Main Street: Replaced air pack filling station, purchased Engine-3, a new mini pumper, gear dryer, and repainted interior
- Champlain, Center, Malletts Bay, and Saint Michael's: Bunker gear for firefighters, new hose and hose connectors so hose from any engine could be connected together
