Storm Update:

At-Home COVID-19 Tests Available to Order

As of Dec. 15, each household in the United States became eligible to receive a new set of four <u>at-home tests</u> in the mail.

Those interested in the no-cost tests can place their orders at <u>covidtests.gov</u>. Help also is available on the phone at 800-232-0233.

The rapid antigen tests are being delivered through the U.S. Postal Service. People who order them are urged to <u>check their mail</u>, as cold temperatures can lead to inaccurate results.
