# Manager's Message

In a little over a month, Town Meeting Day will be here! The Annual Town Meeting will resume in-person this year, and will be held Monday, March 6, 2023 at 7:00 pm at the Colchester High School Auditorium. The ballot items, to be voted on by Australian Ballot, can be found at the following link, but will also be presented at the Annual Town Meeting:

Voting by Australian Ballot will take place Tuesday, March 7, 2023 from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm at Colchester High School, but early/absentee voting is also an option. Your Town staff wants you to be informed about what you're voting on, so we will also be sharing details on the ballot items throughout the month. As a new initiative, we wanted to begin by introducing the **Colchester Recreation Center** ballot item:



#### What is the Colchester Recreation Center?

The Colchester Recreation Center will be considered by voters on the Town Meeting Day ballot in March 2023. The construction of the Colchester Recreation Center, a 29,427 square foot multi-generational facility, responds to a community need that has been identified over the past 20 years through multiple surveys, community outreach and engagement.



The Colchester Recreation Center will include:

- Full-size, multi-purpose gymnasium
- Elevated walking/running track
- Locker rooms
- Kitchen
- Classrooms and studio space
- Cardio/weight room

#### Where will the Colchester Recreation Center be located?

The Colchester Recreation Center will be located on the town-owned 14-acre parcel, known as the Bayside/Hazelett property, with proposed access on Blakely Road, directly across from Laker Lane. This property was purchased in 2004 with voter approval.



#### What will the cost be for the Colchester Recreation Center?

The project will cost \$15,907,000, which includes site development, building, equipment and solar arrays.

#### How will it be paid for?

This project will be paid entirely from current and future proceeds generated from the existing 1% Local Option Tax (LOT). There is currently \$9,000,000 in available proceeds from the LOT, and to cover the remaining, a \$6,907,000 loan will be repaid from LOT proceeds over a ten-year period. **NO PROPERTY TAXES** will be needed for this project:

\$9,000,000 in available proceeds from the LOT as of 6/30/2023
+\$6,907,000 loan will be paid from LOT proceeds over a ten-year period
\$15,907,000 paid entirely from LOT proceeds

#### What is the LOT?

The 1% Local Option Tax is a tax applied to all taxable goods sold in the Town of Colchester and was approved by Colchester voters on Town Meeting Day 2015. LOT proceeds may only be used for voter approved projects.



## How will operating costs be paid for once the Recreation Center is open?

Membership and facility use fees will cover the operating expenses.

**NO PROPERTY TAXES** will be used for operating costs of the Colchester Recreation Center.


