Manager's Message Aaron Frank, Town Manager



The Selectboard authorized the sale of a vacant residential lot on Canyon Estates Drive to Green Mountain Habitat for Humanity on February 14, 2023. This resolves an unfortunate matter that begin in 2018 when the home on the lot was destroyed by fire and neither the owner nor the mortgage holder were willing or able to make the property safe by removing the building, asbestos and filling in the basement. The Town paid for the removal of the remaining structure, took possession of the property, and tried to sell the land through a tax sale bid process. This process did not yield bids, so the town purchased the land itself and obtained a septic permit to prove the lot could be redeveloped. The Selectboard determined that Green Mountain Habitat was interested in the lot and was offered \$80,000 which covered most of the demolition costs. The Selectboard received a note from David Mullin, the CEO of Green Mountain Habitat for Humanity, noting "Your support by making this property available for Habit to purchase is a symbol of how everyone can do something to help make affordable housing possible."

Fees:

Fixed dog \$15.00

Non-fixed dog \$20.00

To avoid an additional \$5.00 fee, license your dog before April 1st.

The state of Vermont requires all dogs to be licensed with their town. A current rabies certificate along with proof of spay/neuter and fee is needed to issue the license and tag.
