

From November 15th to March 15th, no vehicles may be parked within the Town's public streets between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. We would also like to remind residents that pushing, blowing, or placing snow within the

Town's right of way, including sidewalks, is also prohibited.

We thank you for your cooperation in assisting the Public Works crew in our efforts to keep Colchester's transportation network safe for all.



Colchester Police, Rescue, and Fire Departments, along with many surrounding emergency services agencies, are participating in Operation Firecuffs again this year. Operation Firecuffs is a joint effort to collect toys for the children at the University of Vermont Medical Center. This is the 12th year of the annual event.

Drop-off locations include the Police station at 835 Blakely Rd (open 24/7) and the Town Offices at 781 Blakely Rd (M-F, 7:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.). **Donations can be dropped off any time before Thursday, December 21**st. That afternoon, all of the participating agencies will send an emergency apparatus filled with toys to the hospital to deliver the toys with Santa Claus.
