Public Works Update on Malletts Bay Sewer

The Town's contractor has completed the installation of the Main Line Gravity Sewer from Prim Road to the intersection of West Lakeshore/Blakely/East Lakeshore. This portion of the work presented the greatest challenge to the driving public and is now complete.

The contractors will continue work until the end of the construction season (likely late November) including:

- Installation of a manhole structure at the northwest corner of West Lakeshore/East Lakeshore/Blakely Intersection.
- Pressure testing of Main Line Gravity Sewer installed along West Lakeshore.
- Night work to install eight sewer laterals from the waterside of West Lakeshore to the land side of West Lakeshore.
- Pavement restoration of the trenchline on West Lakeshore Drive, which will require alternating lane closures similar to the Main Line Gravity Sewer construction.
- Installation of the Blakely Sewer Force Main towards Severance Corners.



We anticipate continued traffic delays and impacts as the contractors complete their work for the fall. However, we anticipate this work will be generally less impactful to the traveling public.

The Malletts Bay Sewer Project is an environmental abatement project that will provide municipal sewer service to properties with frontage on West Lakeshore Drive between Prim Rd and the Bayside intersection, all of East Lakeshore Drive, and Goodsell Point.
