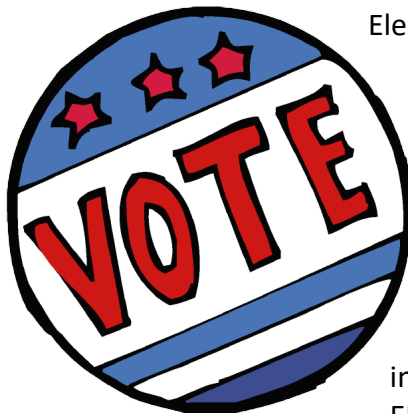

Election Day is **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5<sup>th</sup>**.

ABSENTEE/EARLY VOTERS have until **Monday, November 4<sup>th</sup>, 4:30 p.m.** to return ballots to the Green Drop Box located between Town Hall and the Police Department. On Election Day, you may also drop your ballots at the CHS Gym Help Desk.

THOSE VOTING IN PERSON must bring the ballot they were sent in the mail and be checked off the checklist before voting. Elections open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m.

If you are not yet registered to vote or are unsure of your status, you may go to <https://sos.vermont.gov/elections/voters/registration/> to register or check your status. You may register to vote up until and including Election Day.
