# Public Works Update on Malletts Bay Sewer

## Overall Update:

The two current contracts

- Contract 2 Blakely Road Force Main
- Contract 1A West Lakeshore Drive and East Lakeshore Drive Gravity Main

Both Contracts are continuing to advance and are anticipated to be shut down by the end of November. The Town staff and contractors are looking forward to making your daily commute more routine without interruptions. We appreciate your patience throughout this construction season.





#### West Lakeshore Drive:

The Town's contractor, J. Hutchins has completed:

- Installation of the Main Line Gravity Sewer from Prim Road to the intersection of West Lakeshore/Blakely/East Lakeshore
- Installation of a manhole structure at the northwest corner of West Lakeshore/East Lakeshore/Blakely Intersection
- Installation of the sewer laterals from the waterside of West Lakeshore Drive to the land side of West Lakeshore Drive

November 4th-November 22nd J. Hutchins will be working:

- On pressure testing of Main Line Gravity Sewer installed along West Lakeshore
- Early to mid-November on the asphalt repaving of the road surface along the trenchline on West Lakeshore Drive. This will require alternating lane closures similar to the Main Line Gravity Sewer construction.

Between April and September 2025 J. Hutchins will resume their work on East Lakeshore Drive installing the main sewer line from the intersection with Blakely to South Bay Circle.

### **Blakely Road:**

The Town's contractor, Kingsbury will continue to work on the installation of the Blakely Sewer Force Main for the month of November including:

- Working outside of the roadway just north of Blakely Road by the interstate, on the Force Main Sewer
- Restoration of roadway surface with asphalt patches
- Relocation of project material and equipment to secure sites
- Cleanup and soil stabilization

Between April and September 2025 Kingsbury will complete the Blakely Road Force Main.


## Congratulations to American Legion Post 91 on its 25th Anniversary

American Legion Post 91 first began in Winooski at the RVA (Regular Veterans Association) in 1999 and today is Vermont's second largest post. Post 91 supports a broad array of services for veterans that connect veterans with housing, food, VA resources and more. Post 91 also supports children's programs including Special Olympics, educational scholarships, Boys and Girls State, and toy drives for families.

Fundraising efforts for the post's programs and services continue through Sunday breakfasts, weekday lunches, and Thursday dinners that are open to the public, as well as space rental for group events such as wedding receptions.
