### Volunteer for Green Up Day!

Green Up Day will be here soon! This year, Green Up Day will be held **Saturday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>**.

Residents, businesses, and community groups are invited to join the effort to clean up the Town's roads, beaches, parks, and bike paths. You can pick up bags and road assignments at the Police Station on Blakely Road between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on Green Up Day.



You may select your own Town road or area to clean, provided it has not already been assigned, and can work as many hours as you want.

The Conservation Commission, which coordinates Green Up Day efforts for the Town, will provide instructions on where to leave bags for pick up by the Town's road crews.

Bags and a sign-up sheet will be available at the Police Station the weekend before Green Up Day (April 26 & 27).

Last year, 698 volunteers participated in Green Up Day, collecting 6.97 tons of trash (the most in Chittenden County!).

Thank you to all who coordinate and participate in this event, we hope to see you on May 3<sup>rd</sup>!

### 2025 Capital Paving Program Start Up

The Town of Colchester Capital Paving Program is returning for the 2025 construction season. Starting the week of April 21, 2025, local contractor, FW Whitcomb will begin roadwork operations to repair and restore roads in the community.

Roads to be repaved starting the week of April 21<sup>st</sup> include: Rathe Road, Lower Mountain View Drive between the Maplefields Gas Station and Spare Time Bowling Alley, and Lavigne Road.



Roads to be repaved later this season, pending coordination of adjacent work, include: Shore Acres Drive, Summit Ridge, Hillcrest Lane, Cedar Ridge Drive, and Mill Pond Road.

Paving operations may impact mailboxes overhanging roadway curbing. Mailboxes installed in the right of way should be 6”- 8” back from the edge of the road, and not overhang into the roadway. Residents and businesses should confirm that their mailboxes are installed correctly, as it is the property owner’s responsibility to provide and install mailboxes.

Please be advised that traffic controls will be in effect during operations, and regular working hours are between 7:00 am and 5:00 pm.

## A Message from VTrans: Exit 17 Construction Update

**DATE:** Friday, April 18, 2025

**SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT:** The construction of the new Interstate 89 Exit 17 northbound ramps will require nighttime closures in the upcoming weeks. Traffic will be maintained via an off-site detour during these closures.

The work is scheduled for two weeks: from Sunday, May 4, at 7 p.m. to Friday, May 9, at 6 a.m., and from Sunday, May 11, at 7 p.m. to Friday, May 16, at 6 a.m. The Exit 17 northbound off-ramp will be closed to traffic between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. each night, with periodic closures of the Exit 17 northbound on-ramp between May 11 and May 16. During the off-ramp closures, northbound traffic will be directed to exit the interstate at Exit 18, turn right onto U.S. Route 7, and travel approximately 9.5 miles south to the Chimney Corner intersection of U.S. Route 2 and U.S. 7. During the on-ramp closures, northbound traffic will be detoured to U.S. 7 at the Chimney Corner intersection, travel approximately 9.5 miles north on U.S. 7, and re-enter I-89 at the Exit 18 interchange in Milton. Temporary traffic control signage and portable changeable message boards will be installed along the detour route to guide travelers.
