



## **Planning and Zoning:**

The Chittenden County Regional Planning Commission (CCRPC) is working with cities and towns to implement a regional Future Land Use Map that will help guide how land in the region will be used in the future.

CCRPC will be leading a mapping workshop on **Tuesday**, **April 29**<sup>th</sup>, **from 6:30 p. – 8:15 p.m. at the Colchester Town Offices**.

At this workshop, you will learn about the Future Land Use Mapping process, have a chance to ask questions, and be able to view and provide feedback on the map.
