

A Message from VTrans: Exit 17 Construction Update

DATE: Friday, June 20, 2025

TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION: From Monday, June 23, through Friday, June 27, there will be lane closures and lane shifts on U.S. 7 between the Shell Gas Station and Wiley Road and on U.S. 2 between Jasper Mine Road and U.S. 7.

Motorists should slow down, use caution, and pay attention to road signs and flaggers while traveling through the project limits.
