Manager's Message Aaron Frank, Town Manager

Town Hall & Library Closure - Friday, July 4

Colchester Town Hall, the Burnham Memorial Library, and the Colchester Recreation Center will be closed Friday, July 4, in observance of Independence Day.



Municipal Services Tax Rate

At their last meeting, the Selectboard voted to approve the municipal services tax rate for FY26 at \$0.6745 per hundred dollars of assessed property value. This rate results in a 5.57% increase over last year's rate, or a \$107 increase in municipal services taxes for a property with an assessed value of \$300,000.

This municipal services tax rate is higher than what was estimated during the FY26 budget process due to recent changes at the state level.

The State of Vermont, through legislation, took over valuation of utilities for the purpose of both municipal services taxes and state education taxes. This legislation required the State Tax Department to come up with a new methodology for such assessment and also made utility assessment not appealable by the Town. After the first year of this new system, utility value in Colchester decreased by \$4,925,800 which caused a higher tax rate than the Town estimated by eliminating 34% of the growth in the value of property in Colchester in the last year.



Based on the 2024-2025 Municipal Services Tax Rates from Town Lister/Assessor data, Colchester has maintained the second-lowest municipal services property taxes per resident in inner Chittenden County at \$829. Colchester's municipal services taxes are approximately 15% below average when compared to other inner Chittenden County communities.
