### **Colchester Bikepaths** The Colchester Causewav

A four-mile long path that extends out into the middle of Lake Champlain and offers stunning views of the Green Mountains to the East, the Adirondack Mountains to the West, and the Lake Champlain. Park (500 Colchester Point Road) and connects to South Hero. Cyclists can take the bike ferry across "The Cut" of the Causeway to reach the South Hero

#### Island Line Bike Ferry

The Island Line trail starts at the Burlington Waterfront and runs North through to the Champlain Rutland Railroad bed, including the bridge connecting the path from Burlington into Colchester. Local Motion - a non-profit that supports cycling and alternative transportation - operates a seasonal bike ferry to transport cyclists across "The Cut" of the Causeway and over to South Hero. #### The Colchester Recreation Path

This Town-maintained path is frequented by residents and visitors alike as a means of recreation and transportation. Starting at the beautiful Bayside Park (2 West Lakeshore Drive), the Colchester Recreation Path travels off road and meanders through wooded areas connecting many Colchester neighborhoods and ending at the Creek Farm neighborhood.

#### Lake Champlain Byway

The Lake Champlain Byway is a collection of interconnected scenic roadways designated by the State of Vermont for their unique collection of intrinsic and scenic assets. From North to South, the formal route is 134 miles (215 km) and travels U.S. Route 2 through the Champlain Islands, U.S. Route 7 through Milton, Colchester, Winooski, Burlington, and several surrounding towns, concluding in Addison County. # **Agritourism**

## **Historic Sites**

Yet another treasure tucked away at Airport Park, the Colchester Historical Society's restored Log Schoolhouse serves as a visitor's information center and museum and is open on weekends throughout the summer. The original Log Schoolhouse was built c.1815 and restored in 2004 and remains one of the oldest known structures in Colchester. Original woodwork and period-era furniture adorn this one-room schoolhouse, accentuated by old photographs and historical trivia.
